MILWAUKEE BOAT CLUB MINUTES FOR JANUARY 24, 2008

The Milwaukee Boat Club meeting for January 24, 2008 was called to order at 6:55 P.M. by Commodore Pete Merryfield. Before the meeting, members socialized and partook of the delicious appetizers that were served.

The minutes of the November 15, 2007 meeting were read and approved with no additions or corrections.

Guests Patty Heibel and Jim Palmieri were introduced and warmly welcomed. They have submitted their application for membership into MBC.

Officers' Reports:

Vice-Commodore – No report. Because Grey and Cindy just can't seem to get enough of our extremely snowy winter weather, they are on a skiing vacation in Colorado. Commodore Pete will be presiding over the 2008 event planning in Grey's absence.

Senior Pilot – Wayne Happel, who also represents LMYA, informed us that the proposed ordinance for a five-mile per hour no-wake rule in the inner harbor during special events is in the same stage it has been. The Milwaukee Public Works Department has asked area boating clubs to post and publish the ordinance draft. It is hoped that the ordinance will be passed before the ice is off the lake. Commodore Pete told members that he has sent a letter on behalf of Milwaukee Boat Club expressing our support for passage of the ordinance.

Purser – Dave Dörner reported a starting balance of \$2,115.07. Total income for the period of 11/15/07 to 1/23/08 was \$2,447.00. Total expenses for that period were \$2,189.53 (which includes \$1,664.53 for the "Commodores' Ball" held at the Clarion Hotel). Cash accounts totaled \$1,081.59 for a final balance of \$2,401.80.

Director of Membership – Bonnie Merryfield reported that as of tonight we have 76 regular members and eight honorary members. Bonnie also informed members that Nita Swartwout told her that Jeff Addie, who is continuing to battle cancer, was readmitted to St. Luke's Hospital last night. Jeff appreciates all the kind thoughts and prayers being sent his way.

Director of Programs – Jim Heyden reported that he is in the negotiation stages with a speaker for our February educational meeting.

Co-Directors of House & Equipment – Daryl and Christine Grubbs ask you to notify them if there is anything that you feel we need.

Webmaster – Daryl reminded members that in December he added new information on our website regarding Todd Weiler's quest for the complete story of his uncle's squadron, which was shot down during WWII. It is a fascinating story that continues to evolve.

There were no committee reports.

Any old business? – Not at this time.

Any new business? – Since Vice-Commodore Grey Halstead was out of town, Commodore Pete presented the 2008 Events Schedule. Members offered suggestions and volunteered to captain the various events. The membership also agreed to invite members of Waukesha Cruise Fleet, Milwaukee Harbor Yacht Club, and McBoat (McKinley Marina's Boat Owners' Assoc.) to several of our 2008 events.

Members enthusiastically continued the event planning following an intermission for great pizza and delectable desserts.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:35 P.M.
